The **2010 Clinical AAC (CAAC) Research Conference** on **October 8 - 10, 2010** (Friday-Sunday) is the fourth **annual** forum created specifically for clinicians and researchers engaged in the study and clinical management of people who use augmentative and alternative communication. CAAC Research Conference offers interaction opportunities with leading researchers providing unique insights into clinical research. All CAAC Research Conference participants are required to present their original research and engage in comprehensive discussions with colleagues.\* To encourage a program conducive to the exchange of ideas, attendance will be limited to approximately 100 people.
