6th Summer Seminar on Literacy in Augmentative Communication

June 14-19, 2009

Dr. Karen Erickson and Dr. David A. Koppenhaver will be co-teaching the 6th Summer Seminar on Literacy in Augmentative Communication at the University of Florida after a one-year hiatus.

Course Description:

Participants will engage in an intensive week focused on literacy instruction and assessment, classroom problem-solving, and use of assistive technologies to support the literacy learning of children with severe communication impairments. Instructional methods will include lecture and demonstration, simulation, examination of written and classroom performance samples, and case studies. Monday through Friday, days will be from 8:30 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. with some optional night workgroups. Sunday evening, there is a meet and greet for all participants.

Registration Cost:	\$750 for the week
Credits:	Teacher in-service points, graduate course credit offered (3 hours graduate credit involves an additional fee and project requirement)
Housing:	A limited number of dorm rooms are available for the duration of the course. Cost: \$145/week. A block of hotel rooms are also available at the Paramount Hotel for \$79/night.

This class is limited to 30 participants. All registration forms must be sent in WITH payment by **May 29, 2009**, to reserve a slot.
