

Parts of Speech Pages. Done in WORD, if you need them some other file type, let me know.

I have Verbs, Nouns, Adjectives, and Verbs, for each core symbol on the 84 location. Really it is pretty easy. On your regular WP, create a table. I do 22 rows, 5 columns, autofit. Some may be a little different, due to words I have added, or colors that we have changed on ours. BUT, you get the main idea.

Once someone has learned to do even a two column table, it lends itself to making flashcards, with icons and words for site words, practice sentences, books, vocabulary, you name it. Before I figured out how to do the parts of speech pages (where all the parts are in one spot), I did each site word, on one flashcard. I think I did 4 columns, and 10 rows, autofit. I would put the icon sequence, then the word for it, underneath. I did this for all the DOLCH words, and the 100 most used words lists. Then, I would laminate these cards, and put them on a ring, then I got even more creative and easier. I made a site word dictionary for my daughter. I took those business card holder pages that you buy, and stuck them in a cheap paper folder. Then, I stuck each flashcard, without laminating, in each pocket, alphabetically. I suggest you leave one blank on each page, in case you add words to your dictionary. SAVES having to move them all around, each time.

I figure if you get your children to find the 100 most used words, they have a working knowledge of how to access 70% or more of the spoken English Language.
